- Graduates need to order their caps, gowns, tassels and honor cords prior to the event. These items will be shipped directly to the student.

- Friends and family can watch from inside their cars directly in front of the stage, and MHCC faculty and staff will line the route to cheer the graduates along the way.
- Social Media posting opportunities and a pre-recorded video will be available.
