1) Health Occupations

1) A Healthcare professional will know the academic subject matter required for proficiency within their area. They will use this knowledge as needed in their role.

- 1) 81.82 % demonstrate basic knowledge of human structure, function and development (chemical, cellular, tissue, organ and systems)
- 2) 59.09% can recognize body planes, directional terms, quadrants, and cavities.
- 3) 75% can analyze basic structure and function of the human body including the effects of growth, development and aging.
- 4) 86.36 can describe common diseases and disorders and treatment associated with each body systems (prevention, pathology, diagnosis, and treatment)
- 11) 54.55% can record time using 24-hour clock.
- 12) 85.86% can use roots, prefixes, and suffixes to communicate medical information.
- 13) 67.05% can use medical abbreviations to communicate healthcare information.

2) B Healthcare professionals will understand how their role fits into their department, their organization and the overall healthcare environment. They will identify how key systems affect services they perform and quality of care.

3) C Healthcare professionals will understand the existing and potential hazards to clients, co-workers, and self. They will prevent injury or illness through safe work practices and follow health and safety policies and procedures.

- 1) 90.91% can explain and demonstrate infection control practices and procedures.
- 2) 59.09% can practice appropriate cleaning, disinfecting, and sterilizing processes.
- 4) 72.73% can employ personal safety procedures based on Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and Centers for Disease Control (CDC) regulations (including standard precautions).
- 8) 63.64% can apply safety techniques to prevent accidents and to maintain a safe work environment.
- 9) 90.91 can discuss the rationale for complying with regulatory mandates around disposal and handling of environmentally damaging hazardous substances.

4) D Healthcare professionals will understand the roles and responsibilities of individual members as part of the healthcare team, including effective and sensitive interaction with all members of the healthcare team.

- 5) 86.36% can analyze attributes and attitudes of an effective team member.
- 7) 86.36% can apply effective techniques for managing team conflict.
- 8) 96.97% can understand and demonstrate effective use of different communication styles in healthcare settings.

5) E Understand the legal responsibilities, limitations, and implications of their actions within the healthcare delivery setting while performing their duties according to regulations, policies, laws, and legislated rights of clients.

- 8) 68.18% can maintain confidentiality according to Health Information Portability Access Act (HIPAA).
- 9) 59.09% can apply the doctrine of informed consent.

6) F Healthcare professionals will understand accepted ethical practices with respect to cultural, social, and ethnic differences within the healthcare environment. They will perform quality healthcare delivery.

- 1) 75.76% can differentiate between ethical and legal issues impacting health care.
- 4) 68.18% can apply ethical behaviors in healthcare.
- 8) 90.91% can discuss the impact of religions and cultures on those giving and receiving healthcare with an understanding of past and present events.
- 9) 100% can demonstrate respect of individual cultural, social, and ethnic diversity within the healthcare environment.

7) G Healthcare professionals will apply technical skills required for all career specialties. They will demonstrate skills and knowledge as appropriate.

- 1) 93.18% can apply skills to obtain Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), automated external defibrillator (AED), foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO) and first aid certification.

8) H Healthcare professionals will understand how employability skills enhance their employment opportunities and job satisfaction. They will demonstrate key employability skills and will maintain and upgrade skills, as needed.

- 1) 63.64% can classify personal traits or attitudes desirable in a member of the healthcare team.
- 2) 93.18% can summarize basic professional standards of healthcare workers as they apply to appropriate hygiene, dress, language, confidentiality and behavior (I.e. courtesy and self-introductions).
- 3) 100% can apply employability skills in healthcare.
- 4) 84.09% can exemplify professional characteristics.
