



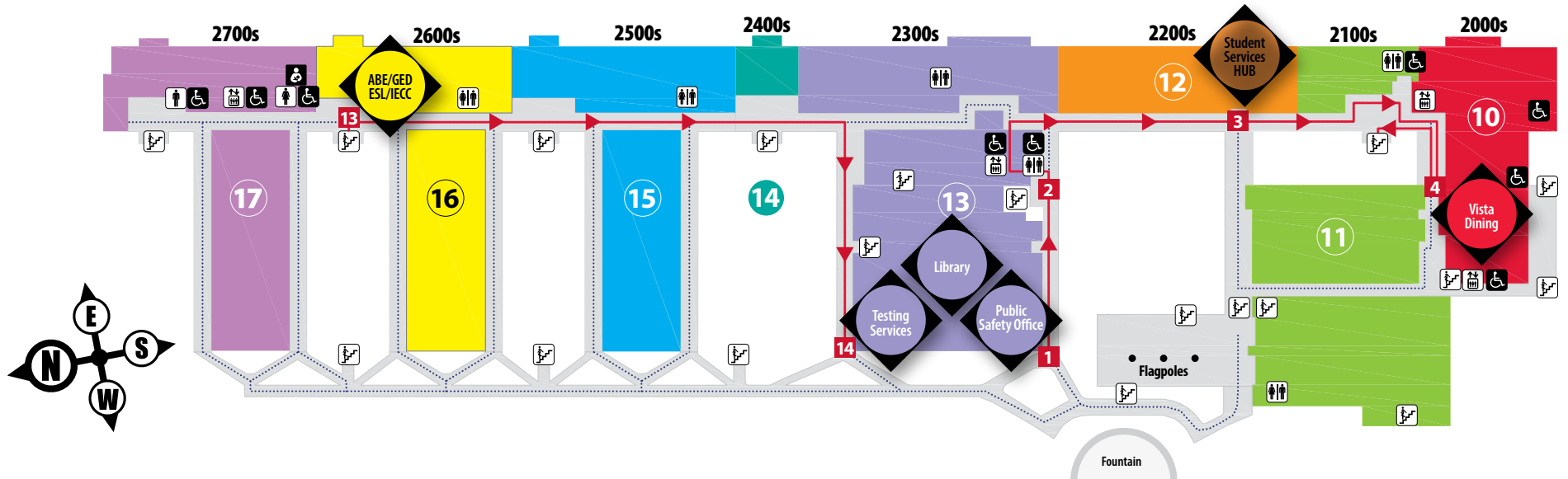
SELF-GUIDED CAMPUS TOUR

Follow map with instructions

- 1. Public safety office (Room 2330):** Find parking information and safety resources. MHCC's public safety officers are on the Gresham campus 24 hours a day, seven days a week. In addition to responding to emergency calls, they can also provide first aid response, safety escorts between classes and to parked vehicles, vehicle battery jumpstarts, and vehicle unlocks.
- 2. Library (Room 2300-2304):** Get your student ID, print and make copies, borrow books, study in designated spaces, relax in the meditation room, get free math and science tutoring, and learn about TRIO services for first-generation college students.
- 3. Student Services HUB (Room 2253):** Get answers to your general MHCC questions such as steps to getting started at MHCC, financial aid, registering, enrolling and withdrawing from classes, connecting to other departments, scheduling advising appointments, making payments, and getting accessible education services.
- 4. Vista dining (Room 2002):** Visit this large, open space to study, hold group meetings, and enjoy light refreshments.
- 5. Student union (Room 1051):** The student "hangout" spot where you can grab a complimentary snack from Barney's pantry. Play pool, table tennis, and air hockey. Show off your musical talent on the piano. Relax in one of the lounging areas. Find a variety of clubs and organizations here such as the Multicultural Diversity Center, Associated Students of Mt. Hood Community College (ASMHCC), Rho Theta Chapter honor society, and more.
- 6. Visual arts village (Bldg. 19):** Enroll in art courses for both credit and non-credit-seeking students. Studios are equipped with specialty equipment such as a 3D printer. View the art gallery to see work from students, faculty, and featured artists.
- 7. Yoshida event center/gym (Bldg. 1):** On your way to our gymnasium, enjoy a view of 40 acres of grass and trees next to the MHCC pond. With a 2,000-seat capacity, the gym offers a variety of health, athletic, and fitness classes. Just past the gym is the aquatic center which has both indoor and outdoor pools along with an indoor rock wall.
- 8. Career planning and counseling center (Room 1152):** Your mental well-being is just as important as intellectual well-being. Receive personalized mental health counseling services along with career coaching, resume help, and interview prep.
- 9. Basic needs center (Room 1261):** Get access to the resources you need to be successful such as rental laptops (dependent on availability), food, transportation, information about childcare and housing assistance, and more.
- 10. Planetarium (Room 1305):** View our solar system and beyond like never before with our state-of-the-art simulation projector (currently closed, check mhcc.edu/planetarium/ before visiting).
- 11. Computer lab (Room 1450-1453):** Use a Mac and Windows computer to work on projects, check emails, and more. Onsite staff are available to troubleshoot technical issues. Writing tutors are available to help with assignments and scholarship essays. Talk with our AVID specialists for help with time management and scheduling.
- 12. Applied technologies (Bldg. 18):** Find classes for a variety of skills including welding, machine tool technologies, and automotive programs.
- 13. English as a Second Language (ESL) and GED® (Room 2660):** Take classes to strengthen your English language skills. Classes are available in the morning or evening, in-person or online.
- 14. Testing services (Room 2335):** Visit the testing center to take a variety of exams including college placement testing, college-level examination programs exams, GED® testing, make-up exams, tests for online classes, and more.
